

Clear Brook Aquatics Booster Club Meeting Minutes January 13, 2006

- Meeting Called to Order** Lee Fabling called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.
- Treasurer's Report** On November 28 the balance was \$6,596. We had expenses of \$4,440. These expenses include jingle bells t-shirts, hospitality, back packs, box rental. We also made \$3,800 at Jingle Bells. We have around \$800-\$1,000 pending to receive from Jingle Bells entries. We also have \$250 pending from working at the Texans game on December 24. Current balance is \$6,110
- Swimming/Diving**

- Changes to the swimming/diving schedule.
 - Hospitality for District Diving at Brook.
 - Cy Creek meet on January 20.
 - District Diving at Brook on March 4 and Hospitality.
- Action**
- The District JV meet will be at Lake on January 19.
 - We will need to set-up hospitality for the District Diving at Brook. We will ask Kim Vu if she is interested in overseeing it. The coaches said that lunch and dinner will be needed. The meet starts at 1:00 p.m. and should be done no later than 6:00 p.m.
 - The District Swimming competition will be at North Shore High School on February 4. More information will follow.
- Swimming Banquet**

- The swimming banquet is tentatively scheduled for the first week in March. Options for the banquet are: Landry's in Kemah, Saltgrass, La Riviera Restaurant, Tad Akers, and Elegance on the Bay.

- The coaches set March 2nd as the date for the banquet. Alene and Richard Ahearn will research the possibilities and prices with Landry's and Saltgrass. Ileana Sepulveda contacted La Riviera. - Having another fundraiser in the spring was discussed. Options were given. Victoria Scott recommended a spaghetti dinner. Other ideas were fundraisers through Chick Fillet or Hot Wings. Several issues were discussed. Where will the money be used? What do the kids/coaches want to do? What is the feasibility of the scoreboard? Will the district contribute towards the scoreboard?

- Backpacks – The backpacks are in. Lisa Ruchte presented a contract where the student and parent will have to sign in order to “rent” a backpack. There is a \$25.00 deposit that will be returned to the student when the backpack is returned. This money will also cover for damage done to the backpack. The backpacks will be issue in August 2006. Each backpack will be numbered. It was recommended that a “B” be monogrammed to easily identify the backpacks at meets.
- Letter Jackets - Lisa Ruchte will e-mail the coaches regarding the letter jackets.
- Year Book – Concerns about the aquatics pictures in the yearbook last year. We need to know what to give to the year book to have pictures and names representing the team.
- Pictures – Lee Fabling will talk to the coaches to get a tentative date for the team and individual pictures.
- T-shirts/Sweat suits – Ileana Sepulveda mentioned Marketing Magic, the company that is doing the t-shirts and sweat suits for the La Porte and Friendswood swim teams, with great recommendations from those teams.
- This spring we will not have Battlefield II.

Action

- Backpacks - The booster club approved the contract and the collection of \$25.00 deposit from each student wanting a backpack. Ileana Sepulveda called two different companies to obtain quotes for the monogram work. At Embroid Me it will be \$5.50 for a 2 inch “B”. No set –up fee since they already have the “B” set-up. If we want the “B” bigger than 2 inches then we will need to pay more. At Marketing Magic, there is a set-up fee of \$75.00. Each “B” will cost \$5.00 regardless of the size. They will also work with us on monogramming a number in each backpack.
- Letter Jackets – The coaches will the students the information in the next few weeks.
- Year Book – Ashley Fabling is in the aquatics team and is also a member of the year book. She will find the information for us.
- T-shirts/Sweat Suits – Ileana met with the representative of Marketing Magic. This company is able to provide us t-shirts, sweat suits, embroidery work, etc at very reasonable prices. They also do the t-shirts for the soccer team at Brook.
