

## **Clear Brook Aquatics Booster Club Meeting Minutes April 3, 2007**

**Meeting Called to Order** Lee Fabling called the meeting to order after Ms. Permetti's presentation.

**Treasurer's Report** Last month we had \$8369. Our current balance is \$8,671.

**Secretary's Report** Minutes from the February booster club meeting were distributed.

### **Pool Update**

#### **Discussion and Action**

- Coach Schurdell reported that the contractors are still working on the pool. It will take at least 2 to 3 more weeks for the work to be completed. He hopes to be able to do some water polo when the pool becomes available.

### **Water Polo**

#### **Discussion and Action**

- Next year water polo will be in the fall. The coaches are still deciding when fall practice will start. School starts the last week in August. Most likely the first district game will be the first Tuesday after school starts. They are hoping to have a calendar soon with information about the games, tournaments (including Battlefield). Regarding Battlefield it may have to be in September, possibly the first weekend after school starts. They can not do it in August because many teams may not attend.
- Information regarding the summer water polo program is already posted on the website.

### **Block scheduling**

#### **Discussion and Action**

- Varsity will be 1<sup>st</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> period. JV will be 4<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> period. The incoming freshmen will not be able to do double block. If they are in varsity they will only go 1<sup>st</sup> period. If they are in JV it will only be 4<sup>th</sup> period.

### **Try Outs**

#### **Discussion and Action**

- Try outs are scheduled for June 18. Everyone currently in the team and returning next year (in addition to the incoming freshmen) will have to try out. The coaches are still working on required times to make either varsity or JV. For the varsity team the girls will have to swim in the 100 free a 1:02.99. The boys will have to swim a 59.99 in the 100 free. The coaches are still working on the required times for the other events. A swimmer will only have to make one time in one of the events specified by the coaches. There is going to be a make-up date for try outs that will be announced at a later time.

## **Fundraiser**

### **Discussion and Action**

- The swim-a-thon will be on May 2<sup>nd</sup>. If the pool is not ready it will be at another location. We will be notified.
- Becky Au reported that she collected donations for the scoreboard for a total of \$1,250. She is to send to the webmaster the businesses that donated the money so they can be put on the team website.

## **Uniforms**

### **Discussion and Action**

- We are going to keep the same jogging suits for next year. Lee Fabling presented information regarding the water polo shirt with the player's last name on the back of the shirt. The shirt will be \$7.00 and if the player wants the name it will be an additional \$5.00. Becky Au asked if other bids were taken. The coaches wanted to know if the name on the back could be optional or if all t-shirts will have to have the name on the back.
- It was decided that re-orders for the jogging suits and orders for the water polo suits can be done on a specific date before school is over. The date will be decided and announced. Orders for the swim suit will be after August 1<sup>st</sup> because that is when the new catalog comes out. A second order will be done right after try-outs for incoming freshmen and for swimmers that want to make sure they make the team.
- Ileana is waiting for information from D&J Sports regarding the water polo suit.

## **Other Business**

### **Discussion and Action**

- The coaches announced that some parents have volunteered to help on the board next year. They are waiting to hear from few other parents. So far parents interested in helping as a board member are Ron Freeman and Sandy Bevolo. We will have a complete list to vote and finalize at the next booster club meeting.
